Subject: Qualifying and Race Procedures

Date: January 1, 2011

In order to maintain the spirit of competition, the following procedures will be followed by SVRA until further notice.

Sprint Feature Races: Qualifying time determines Qualifying Race Grid

Qualifying Finishing Position determines Feature Race Grid

Enduros: Best *Time* of Practice, Qualifying Sessions and/or Qualifying Race will

determine Enduro Grid.

Specialty Races: These special õMarqueö races will be treated in the same manner as the

Sprint Races. If the schedule has not allowed a Qualifying Race for the õMarqueö race, then the best time from previous sessions that *allows*

Timing and Scoring to set a grid, will determine Race Grid.

Race Duration: Sprint Races and Specialty Races will be run on a otime plus 1 lap basiso

(Ex. 25 minutes + 1 lap race). This method precludes slower cars in a race Group being õpenalizedö by being lapped by faster cars. No matter what type of car you race in that Group, you will get the same amount of Race

Time. This method also allows better schedule flexibility.

Enduros will continue to be õTimedö events.

Note: The SVRA Grid Marshall reserves the right to slot cars into the Grid in the

interest of safety.
