

## EVENT INFORMATION

Licensing/Credentials: This event is open to competitors that hold a current competition license or have driving privileges from a recognized VMC vintage racing organization and other racing organizations accepted by the SVRA. Make sure you have your Licenses, I.D. and any other documents that you need to submit. If you forget or misplaced your License, it is the participant's responsibility to contact his home organization for proper documentation. No License means NO ON TRACK. If you have questions, contact Alex Miller (alex@svra.com ) SVRA National Licensing Director.

VMC Infraction List: A driver's appearance on the Vintage Motorsports Council Infraction List and/or a history of driver issues, probation or suspension may negate entry for this event. The Race Director will make this determination if warranted.

SVRA Rules Compliance for Car Type, Group and Class: This event is operated under SVRA Vintage Rules. It is the responsibility of the entrant to understand and comply with all of the relevant rules of SVRA. This is especially important regarding Fuel Cell requirements, Competition Bulletins, Technical Bulletins, Safety Requirements and, in particular, Tire Regulations for your particular Race Group. Race Car Compliance Forms, Engine Certification Forms, and Car Photos must be submitted to (rick@svra) no later than June 1st. Car compliance issues must be addressed prior to the event with the SVRA Technical Director, Rick Parent (rick@svra.com).

Head and Neck Restraints: These systems are mandatory for all SVRA events and must meet SFI 38.1 Standards. Exhibition Group and the Oval-Only entrants are exempt of this mandate for this event. Transponders: Required for this event. Please make sure your car is equipped with a transponder, the number has been submitted with your entry and is recorded in an accessible location and available during Tech Inspections. A limited number of rental units are available. Please contact Janet Harhay (jharhay@aol.com) no later than June 8th if a rental is needed.

Tow Hooks/Straps: Every car for this event must have at least a front Tow-Hook or on-board strap to facilitate at least flat towing should the need arise. Strap around the roll bar is NOT adequate.

Schedule: **PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE** --listed on the SVRA Brickyard event site separately will be updated as needed. SVRA reserves the right to change/modify this schedule without notice. With at least 100 multi-car owner entrants, we have tried to limit the amount of back-to-back sessions that occur. Every effort will be made to keep the Official Schedule as close to the Provisional as possible. **Test Day Schedule** is also listed on the SVRA Brickyard Event site.

Driver Packets: Will be provided at SVRA Registration.

Crew Appreciation Laps Thursday night: Crew members in street cars wearing seat belts will be given access to driving the course immediately at the conclusion of the regular race sessions on Thursday (approximately 5:30 PM). Please stage in the grid area and a pace car will escort you onto the track when the track is clear. Please be ready to go as the entire group will need to enter the track together.

Track Walk Thursday night: Immediately following the Crew Appreciation Laps (approximately 6:30 PM), the track will be open for a track walk. Those interested will be able to enter the track from two locations (Start/Finish and Turn 7). One hour will be allotted to the Track Walk. If you are able to complete the whole circuit in one hour, you are welcome to do so. If not, you will need to select one of the two track areas and enter the course accordingly. NO WHEELED VEHICLES (ie golf carts, bikes, scooters, pit carts, etc.) will be allowed on track during this session with the exception of staff driven golf carts accommodating any persons needing assistance.

Banquet and Concert Saturday night: A banquet and concert by the “Impalas” (Central Indiana’s most dynamic and entertaining events band) will be held Saturday night in the plaza. Cash bars will open at 5:30pm, Dinner will start at 6:00pm and the concert will begin approximately 7:00 pm. Drivers will receive 2 tickets with their entry. Additional banquet tickets can be purchased at Registration or Driver Information for \$30 each.



Saturday night Celebration and Concert with Fireworks: SVRA will be hosting a Banquet in the Plaza at the completion of Saturday's on-track activities. Each driver will be given 2 tickets to this event and additional tickets may be purchased at Registration for \$30 each. A concert with "The Guess Who" will follow the banquet and the evening will be capped off with fireworks.

Flaggers/Workers: Credentialed by the SVRA Registration Staff at the IMS Administration Offices on 16th Street.
