

## EVENT FAQs

*WeatherTech Laguna Seca (revised 4.10.19)*

<b>LOCATIONS:</b>	<b>Staging</b>	South Boundary Road Gate (located off General Jim Moore Blvd near the intersection of Canyon Del Ray (Hwy 218) and General Jim Moore Blvd.). Rigs may stage here starting Tuesday, April 30th from 7am-4pm. This is the gate you will need to use for track entrance throughout the event.
	<b>Registration</b>	On the right side of the road at the South Boundary Road Gate
	<b>Tech</b>	At the entrance to the main paddock.
	<b>Timing and Scoring</b>	Timing and Scoring is located across track from the paddock on driver's right just before the Start/Finish Line
	<b>Victory Circle</b>	Next to the Media Center (between the Media Center and the garages)
	<b>Driver Meetings</b>	Newman Building classroom (Test Day mandatory Driver's Meeting at 7:45 am on Friday, Event Mandatory Driver's Meeting at 8:00 am on Saturday)
	<b>Black Flag Station</b>	Turn 7 and Start/Finish
	<b>Food</b>	Cruisin' Café in the paddock will be open starting Thursday, May 2nd at 8am
<b>TRACK SERVICES:</b>	<b>Shipments</b>	Can be sent to: WeatherTech Laguna Seca 1021 Monterey Salinas Highway Salinas, CA 93908 - be sure to include name and at-track telephone number
	<b>Tires</b>	Participants may order race tires for at track delivery mounting and balancing from Roger Krause (510-582-5031) or Tim Gerhardt at Hoosier Tire West (tgerhardt@hoosiertirewest.com or (559) 485-4612).
	<b>Golf Carts</b>	Ordered through GTI (link on website). Please order early to ensure supply is available at the track. Note: all personal golf carts will need to have a golf cart sticker and provide proof of insurance (forms attached) which can be obtained from the Administration office next to the fuel pumps. Please plan ahead. If needed, insurance with the necessary coverage can be obtained from SVRA.
	<b>Fuel</b>	Sunoco, the official racing fuel of SVRA, will be available in the main paddock between turns 10 and 11. The fuel supplier will be Paul Oil (Kerry Rauch, krauch@pauloilcompany.com)
	<b>Waste Handling</b>	Waste fluid "Safety Clean" containers are located near the fuel pumps
	<b>RV Info</b>	OVER-NIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED in your hauler/tow vehicle in the PADDOCK, space permitting and at the direction of the paddock marshalls RV Spots are available near the paddock (Motorcoach reservation form attached)
	<b>Rig Washing Services</b>	Superior Auto Detail (Ron BeVard - 831-601-1831 or juicycarcare@gmail.com) located at Red 9 Parking Lot. Must pre-order service. Rig washing in the paddock is PROHIBITED due to stringent local environmental regulations
	<b>Load in Start time</b>	It is planned that Initial Load-In will begin on Wednesday, May 1st at <b>10:00AM for Lane 1</b> (prep shops, 5th wheel rigs and vendors). Wednesday at approximately <b>11:00AM for Lane 2</b> (all pull along tag trailers sent in to the paddock)
<b>EVENT RULES:</b>	<b>California Vehicle Code Transporter Information</b>	See Attached form for this information and process if you are a combination of vehicles consisting solely of a truck tractor semitrailer combination with a kingpin to the rearmost axle measurement limit of not more than 46 feet, a trailer length of not more than 56 feet, and used exclusively or primarily in connection with motorsports. You will need a permit when traveling in the state of California.
	<b>Times engines can be run</b>	No running of race engines between <b>10:00PM and 7:00AM</b>
	<b>Sunday night stay</b>	<b>Rigs and Haulers must be out of the paddock by noon on Monday, May 6th.</b>
	<b>Animals</b>	Not allowed except for Guide Dogs. Owners must look after their pets
	<b>Shorts in the pits</b>	Yes, except for during the Enduro Races
	<b>Sound limits</b>	Not applicable during this event
	<b>Fire Extinguishers</b>	Each competitor must have a fire bottle displayed in their paddock area with a minimum rating of 10ABC.
	<b>Head &amp; Neck Restraints</b>	Required
	<b>Transponders</b>	Required, limited number available for rental at Tech
