



## 2021 Sebring SpeedTour Sebring International Raceway February 18 - 21, 2021

### *Event Supplemental Regulations*

#### Package pickup

Operations Building located across the bridge behind Turn 17.

#### Staging

Enter from Haywood-Taylor Blvd. then turn left onto Carrol Shelby Drive. Turn left through Gate 4. Jog right onto the Skid pad and pull forward to get into the appropriate lane for your rig, as marked. Please remember, there is no unloading of trailers on the skid pad.

#### Load in

It is planned that Initial Load-In will begin on Wednesday at 1:00PM for SVRA. Load in will end at 6PM on Wednesday and will reopen at 7AM Thursday. Please plan on arriving no earlier than Wed am if possible. **Note, that Trans Am has different load in hours than SVRA, so their rigs will be entering the paddock at different times than SVRA participants.**

#### Registration

Located at the windows on the right side of the Raceway Headquarters Building. After staging on the skid pad lot, follow the fence line to the gate entrance on the left to the registration windows. A mask is required to register. Because of COVID-19, every participant (drivers/crew/staff/etc.) will be required to complete a Sebring waiver as well as a COVID-19 waiver at the Sebring registration window (the 1<sup>st</sup> 2 windows at the end of the bldg.) You will receive a Sebring armband. This is in addition to the SVRA/Trans Am/IGT registration where you will need to sign the SVRA waiver and receive an SVRA armband. Please allow extra time for this new process. This will only need to be done once during the weekend. Once you have received both armbands, you will not be required to return to registration. A mask will be required by all participants and spectators at all times while on the property.

#### Track Entrance

The entrance process has been changed. For load-in you will notice that you have to enter through gate 4 (by the skid pad.) This is for all trailers, haulers, etc. You will need to register before entering the track. If you have not registered and are in a truck or car, you can enter gate 2 (the gate outside of the registration bldg.,) park and come to registration. Once you have registered, you will enter lane 1 at the main gate (gate 1-ticketing) for the rest of the weekend.

## **Tech**

Located mid-paddock. Look for the new tractor trailer with SVRA graphics on the side.

## **Fuel**

Sunoco, the official racing fuel of the SVRA will be available in the far North paddock, down by turn 15. Follow the Sunoco signs on Alan Jay Blvd. to the end. All required blends will be available. The Sunoco contact is Rick Williams (877 2403278) or [rwilliams@portconsolidated.com](mailto:rwilliams@portconsolidated.com) A free 5 gallon fuel jug will be given with a 15 gallon purchase of Sunoco fuel.

## **Waste Fuel**

Waste fluid stations with disposal containers for oil, antifreeze, brake fluid and fuel are available near the gas pumps on driver's left as you enter the paddock.

## **Tires**

Participants may order race tires for at track delivery mounting and balancing from Sasco Sports ( 434-822-7200 or [dave@sascosports.com](mailto:dave@sascosports.com)) You may also order tires through Tire Rack (contact info pending) - you will need to have the tires purchased from Tire Rack shipped to you so you can bring them to the track. SASCO will mount and balance them for you for a fee, but do not have these tires shipped to SASCO.

No garages are available for rental at this venue

## **RV/Camping**

OVER-NIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED in your hauler/tow vehicle in the PADDOCK, space permitting and at the direction of the paddock marshals. Limited electrical is available in the paddock. Water hookups are limited. No dump station on Property. Servicing can be arranged through All Around Septic ([allaroundsepticandsewer@gmail.com](mailto:allaroundsepticandsewer@gmail.com) or 863-655-4700). RV Pumping is \$65.00, Non potable water \$30.00. Tent camping permitted. Camp fires of any type are not permitted. Men's and Women's showers are located throughout the paddock. No overnight camping in area outside Registration
