







There will be no personal cars allowed to park in the paddock due the lack of space. Vehicle parking is in the designated field above the B Paddock. If you detach your tow vehicle, we would appreciate it if you would park with the rest of the personal cars.

The track has a car show on Sunday and requests that the A Paddock is FULL. If you plan on leaving on Saturday, please plan on paddocking in the B Paddock.

We will not allow any saving of space at this event. The SVRA officials will be parking everyone compactly to get everyone paddocked.

Per track rules, rigs over 20,000 lbs or over 40' long must enter the infield via the white line when directed.

Thursday May 23:

• Track Arrival:

- Please stage in the open field.
- o Registration: Opens at 8:00 am. (Official posted schedule)
- Load-In:
 - Is scheduled to being at 9:00 am,
 - If you wish to paddock together you <u>must</u> arrive together.
 - The Trans Am TA2 teams will load-in on Friday, so there is space reserved in the A Paddock. Please do not move any of the caution tape.
 - Once released please follow the white line to the stop sign and an SVRA official will release into your desired paddock area.
 - Another SVRA Official will assist you in parking compactly.

Friday and Saturday:

- Please see posted schedule for registration hours.
- Once registered, please note guidelines for vehicle sizes entering the paddock. Track personnel will manage access via the white line.
 - Ron will meet you at the stop sign to assist you in getting paddocked.

Q: What are the vehicle size limits for entering the infield?

A: Large vehicles can access the infield through two access points. Any vehicle that is under 10 tons (20,000 lbs), 40-feet long and 12-feet wide may use the public entrance (clearing the ticketing overhang and crossing the Bailey Bridge). Any vehicle larger will require a track escort to cross the racetrack. Please call 860.435.5000 in advance for escort information.
