TRACK WAIVER PROCESS

MINORS: Minor paper releases will be completed at the event. All minors attending must come to Registration with a parent or guardian to sign the Minor Release.

ADULTS: Everyone aged 18 and over should complete the online waiver before arrival. Completion of this process ahead of time will decrease your wait time at Registration.

Instructions for Completing the Release:

1. Click on the above link & enter first and last name and mobile phone number
2. Once you receive a text, click on the link in the text to take you to the release platform
3. It will ask to allow access to your camera to take your photo, click allow and then take photo
4. Once the photo is taken it will ask you to sign your name at the bottom of each release
5. After signing both releases you will receive another confirmation text
6. Once onsite you will show your confirmation text at registration and receive a wristband to wear for the duration of the event to indicate the releases are complete.

Staging Location: Polco/16th Street Gravel Lot – take note of SVRA and FR designated lanes

Staging Hours: Wednesday, June 11: 7:00 am – Lot at 16th Street and Polco Rd

Load-In Begins: SVRA/FR – Wednesday, June 11th from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm

Load Out: All trailers must be moved to the Polco Staging Lot by Sunday, June 15 at 7 pm.

Garages: Competitor trailers will be parked in the adjacent transporter lot near the garage area. Trailers must be unloaded in these adjacent lots and moved to your assigned garage.

Garages are available to reserve. Contact your Registrar.

Quiet Hours: No race engines between 8:00 pm and 7:00 am

Cleanliness: It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track. No batteries or petroleum products in the trash cans. All tires must be removed from the facility when you leave.

Personal Vehicles: No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you used it to tow your trailer and it fits in your allocated space. All street cars must be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.

RVs: RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer. A limited number of RV spots will be available for purchase via your registrar.
