Staging Location:	Paved lot in Raceplex, located on Raceplex Drive. Trailers will not be able to disconnect in this area.
Staging Begins:	Wednesday, September 17 th at 12:00 pm
Load Ins:	FR/F4/JFC: Wednesday, September 17 th 2:00 PM - 5:00 PM. Trans Am (TA2®/GT testing with SVRA): Wednesday, September 17 th 3:00 PM - 6:00 PM. Garage Renters: Wednesday, September 17 th 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM. SVRA/IGT: Wednesday, September 17 th 4:30 PM - 6:30 PM. Trans Am (TA/GT Classes): Thursday September 18 th 2:00 PM - 3:30 PM.
Load Out:	Sunday, September 21 st by 7:00 pm. Trucks can be parked in the Staging Lot on Raceplex Drive until Monday morning, but all vehicles must clear the paddock Sunday night.

Quiet Hours:	No race engines between 11:00 pm and 7:00 am.
Cleanliness:	It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.
Paddock Power:	Available at VIR receptacles for \$50 fee per plug-in. You should go to your paddock location and security will be around the next day to collect the fee.
Personal Vehicles:	No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you used it to tow your trailer. All street cars must be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.
RVs:	RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer. See paddock power details above.

VIR does not permit Chlorinated Brake Cleaner on property.
Pets:	Pets are allowed in the paddock and must be always kept on a leash. No pets allowed on grid or pit lane. Owners must clean up after pets. No pets in any VIR buildings or lodging accommodations.

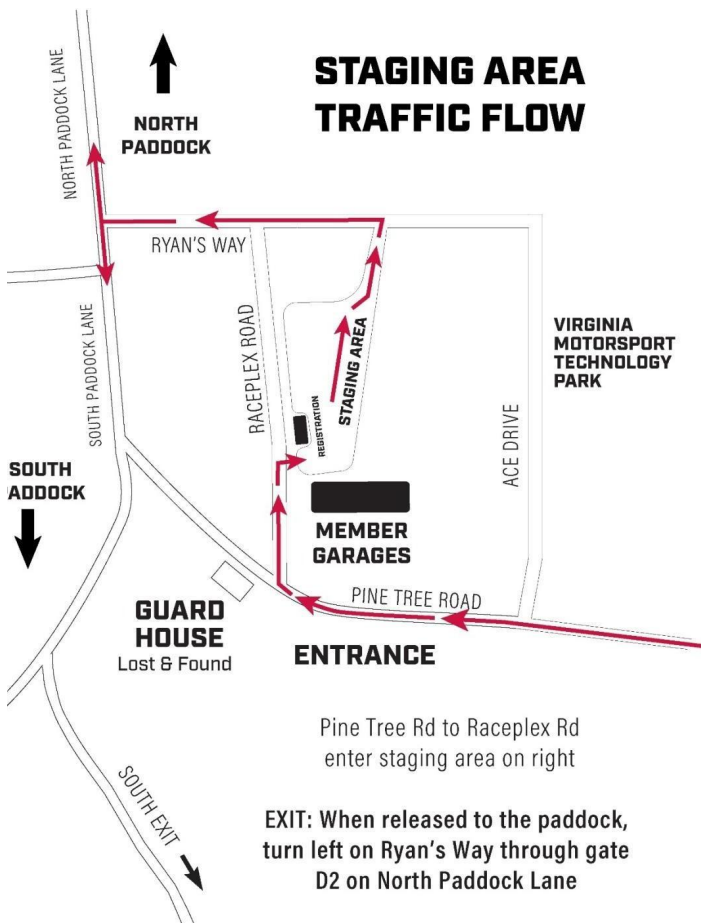

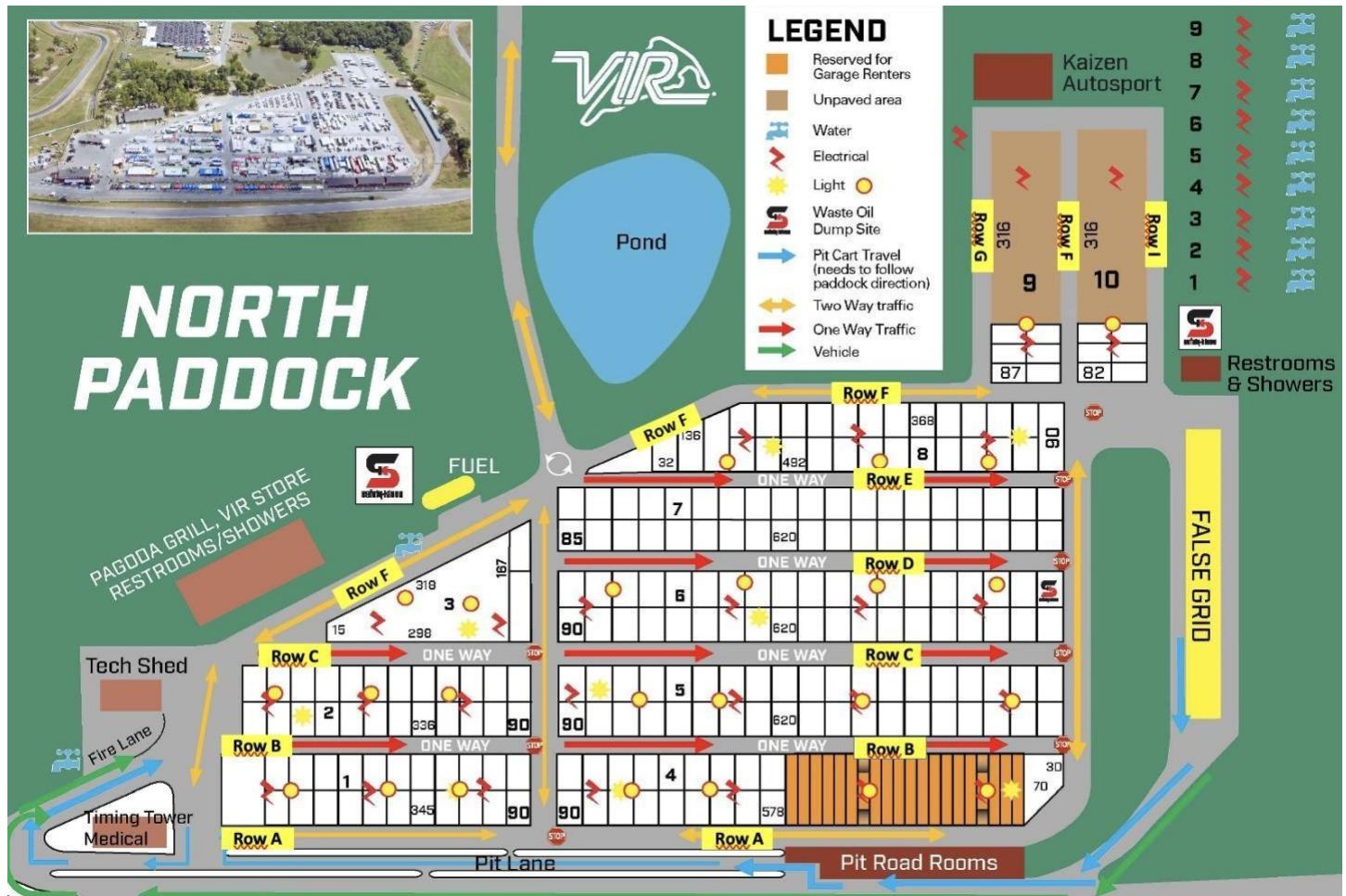

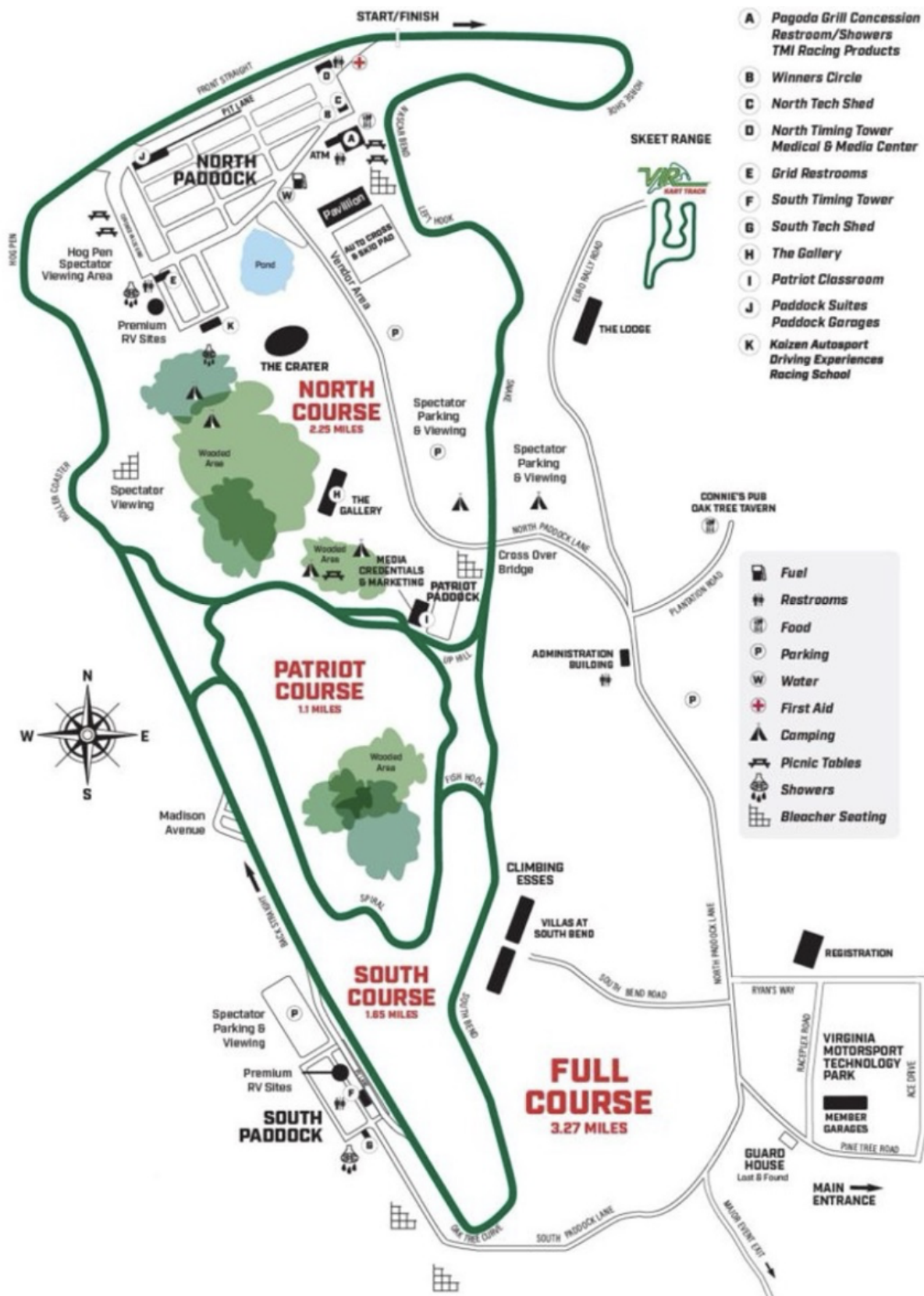
